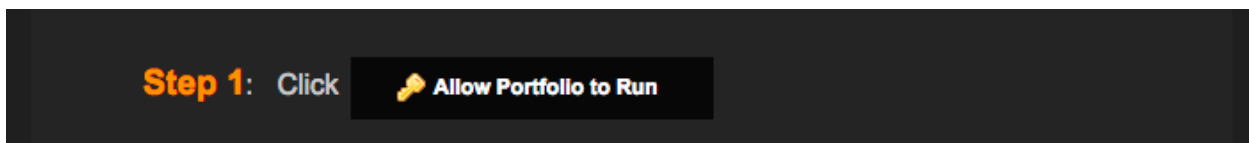


## Chrome 55 And Higher Will Prefer HTML5 Over Flash

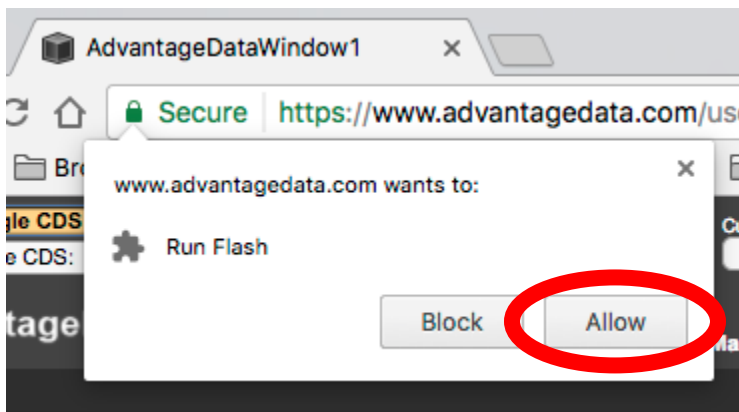
### REMEDIATION

There are five ways to remedy this behavior, ordered by preference:

1. Follow the on-screen instructions.

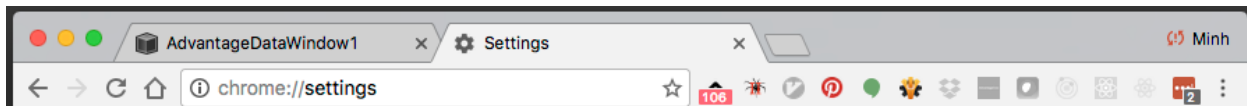


Click **Allow** in the dialog box that appears on your screen:



Effectively, this is setting an **Exception** for **advantagedata.com** that will allow AdvantageData flash content to run. **IMPORTANT:** If you have inadvertently clicked **Block**, you will have to perform this step manually.

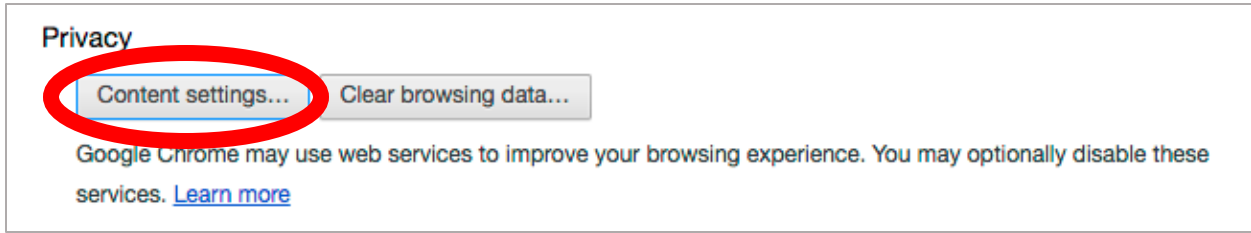
To fix manually, in your browser window, type "**chrome://settings**"



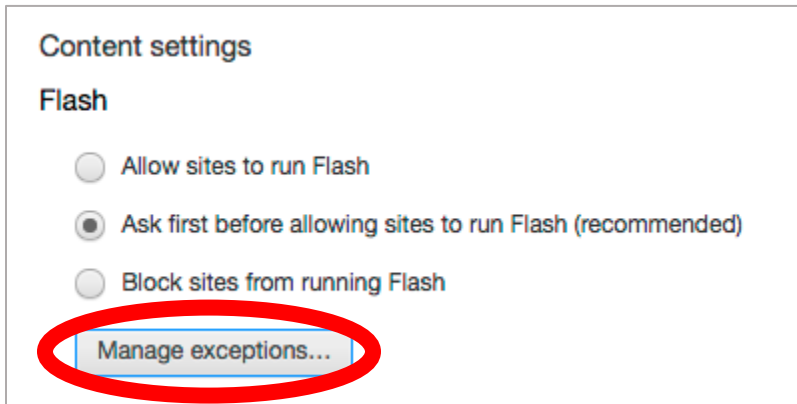
Scroll down and click "Show Advanced Settings"



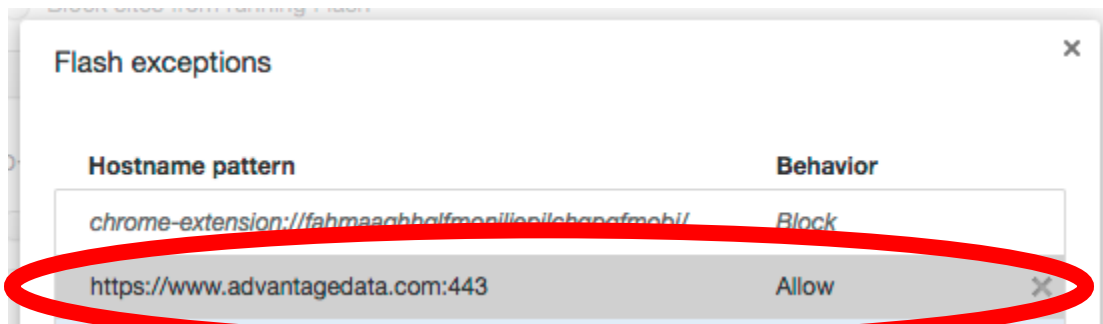
Under Privacy, click "Content setting..."



Under Content settings > Flash, click "Manage exceptions..."



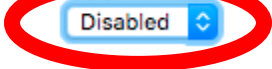
A panel should pop up, where you should add "<https://www.advantagedata.com:443>" to the Allow list



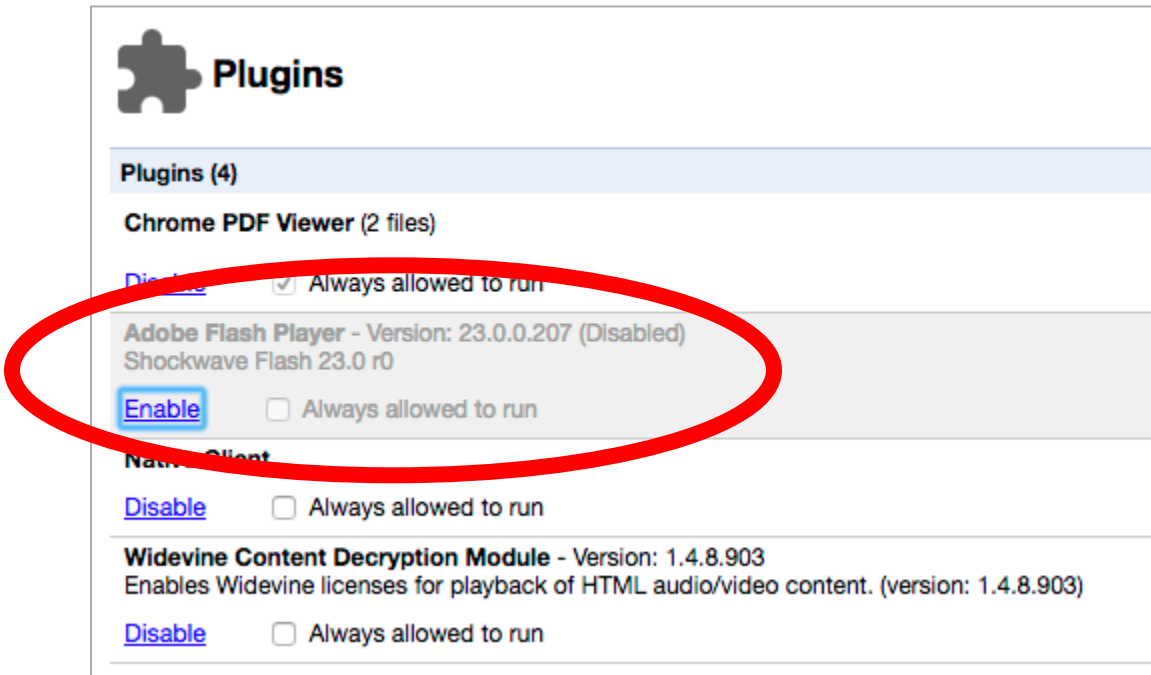
**2.** Visit "<chrome://flags/#prefer-html-over-flash>" in your chrome browser and set **Prefer HTML over Flash** to **Disabled**

**Prefer HTML over Flash** Mac, Windows, Linux, Chrome OS

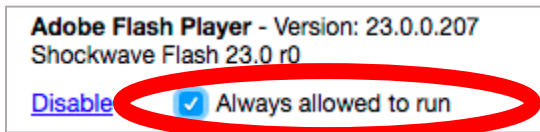
Prefer HTML content by hiding Flash from the list of plugins. [#prefer-html-over-flash](#)



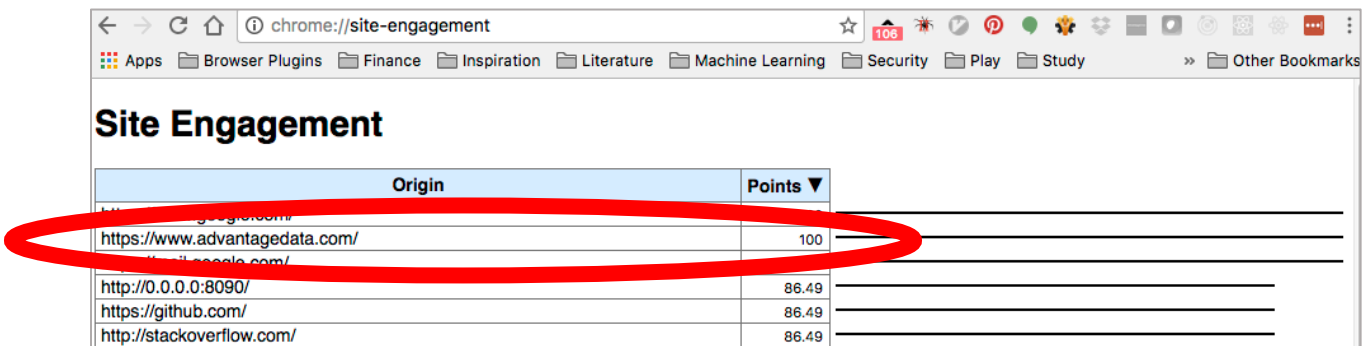
3. Visit "<chrome://plugins>" in your chrome browser and ensure that **Adobe Flash Player** is enabled.



4. Alternately, click **Always allowed to run** as well.



5. Visit "<chrome://site-engagement>" in your chrome browser and manually edit the **Points** for <https://www.advantagedata.com> to 100.
